Public works requested to surplus a 2002 Ford Ranger and a Grasshopper mower. Council approved.

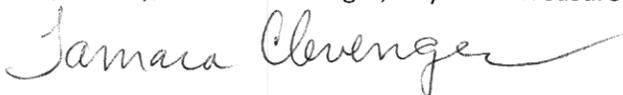
